Guidelines

Contestants must meet the following prerequisites:

- 18 years of age or under
- Currently enrolled in a high school or equivalent program
- May not be or previously have been enrolled at an institution of higher learning, e.g., college, university, conservatory, etc.

Submissions for ALL rounds must meet the following:

- Piano accompaniment is required. Contestants may use recorded accompaniment if circumstances prevent an in-person collaboration
- Contestants should perform in view on a video recording
- Video recordings must be submitted via an unlisted YouTube link
- Contestants must perform using legally-acquired copies of the music

Preliminary Round

Repertoire must include a selection from each section below.

- I. The exposition from the first movement of one of the following:
 - Mozart: Concerto No. 2, 3, or 4
 - Beethoven: Sonata, Op. 17
 - R. Strauss: Concerto No. 1
 - F. Strauss: Concerto, Op. 8
 - Saint-Saens: Morceau de Concert (Beginning Reh. 4)
 - and -
- II. Approximately two minutes of a contrasting solo work of the contestant's choosing
 - N.B. This music may come from a different movement of one of the pieces listed above, or it may come from a separate work of equivalent performance level.

Final Round

Repertoire must include a selection from each section below.

- I. The complete first movement of one of the following:
 - Mozart: Concerto No. 2, 3, or 4 (with cadenza as necessary)
 - Beethoven: Sonata, Op. 17
 R. Strauss: Concerto No. 1
 - F. Strauss: Concerto, Op. 8
 - Saint-Saens: Morceau de Concert (complete)

- and -

- II. A contrasting solo work of the contestant's choosing, presented in its entirety
 - N.B. This music could come from a different part of one of the pieces listed above or it may be a separate solo piece of equivalent performing level
 - Works written for horn alone are encouraged, e.g., the Ketting Intrada, Arnold Fantasy, etc.
